Artist Selection Panel for Oberlin Road Project: Jenn

Budget for the project is \$66K. The artist call is not yet live. We are waiting for the new Public Art Director to be in place. Jenn distributed a list of the selection panel members. Kathleen Rieder will serve as Chair.

Public Art Matrix: Jenn

Public Art Matrix was distributed and reviewed. Updates were provided for the temporary public art projects:

- Nate Sheaffer's neon light and sound project will take place in May at Dix Park. It is being funded by Raleigh Arts with a match from Dix Conservancy.
- Markus Dorninger/OMAI's projection mapping project will take place in June. The proposed interactive site is at St. Augustine's. Pop up events will be held as well.
- Moore Square construction fencing project is in process and partially installed.
- Wilmington Bike Rack Mural, an Urban Design Center and DOT project, has completed a curated artist call. Lidia Churakova was the artist chosen to paint the murals at two sites.
- Artist, Carter Hubbard, is scoping potential sites for an installation of Florafitti (clover plantings) in Spring 2018.
- A handout of ongoing CIP projects was distributed. Updates were provided:
 - Contract for Biltmore Tennis Center has finished routing and artist, DeeDee Morrison is working on her concept design.
 - Phase II of Fire Station 12 will be installed in May
 - Hillsborough Street Phase II is in the fundraising stage
 - Artist, David Wilson, is working with an architect and fabricator for the Chavis Memorial Park project.
 - Lake Johnson is on hold for now.
 - Duke Performing Arts Center would like to add a plaza to the Brian Brush light project at a cost of \$100K. Raleigh Convention Center and Parks will match Raleigh Arts funds.
 - Artist, Vicki Scurri, is working on the final designs for Wade Ave. and Peace Street bridges.

Other Business: Sarah

- Updates were provided on the Together Raleigh bus shelter project.
- A candidate has been chosen for the Public Art Director position and negotiations are underway.
- The December meeting was cancelled. Next meeting will be January 30.
