### Discussion Items

**Police Training Center Presentation:** Cassandra Deck-Brown, Chief of Police

The city is building a state of the art training facility south of the city, near the water treatment plant, that will serve over 800 officers. Raleigh PD and Wake County Sheriffs will be on one campus. All law enforcement officers will be trained at this new facility. Construction is set to begin in April 2019 with a projected completion date of 2020. Raleigh PD is interested in using public art funds to create an RPD museum that would preserve historical information, artifacts, memorabilia, and create a law enforcement legacy. They are currently working in partnership with the COR Museum. Board members agreed that it is a worthy project. Further discussion will be undertaken.

**Transportation Projects:** Chris Johnson

Public Art funding for fourteen transportation projects this fiscal year totals \$998K. Chris provided details on each of the projects which are scattered all throughout the city. They include the following: Old Wake Forest Rd. + Dixie Forest Dr.; Yonkers Rd. from Capital to New Bern; Tryon Rd. Part C from Lake Wheeler to Park Dr.; Poole Rd. from Maybrook to Barwell; Blue Ridge from Duraleigh to Crabtree; Six Forks Corridor from Rowan to Sandy Forks; Barwell Rd. from Rock Quarry to Berkeley Lake Rd.; Blount/Pearson from Hammond to Atlantic; Atlantic Ave. from Highwoods to New Hope Church; Carolina Pines Ave. from Lake Wheeler to South Saunders; Leesville Rd. from Westgate to O'Neal Rd.; and Marsh Creek + Trawick Rd. West from Marsh Creek to Capital Blvd. There was a brief discussion about the utilization of public art funds during which it was agreed that community input will be essential.
