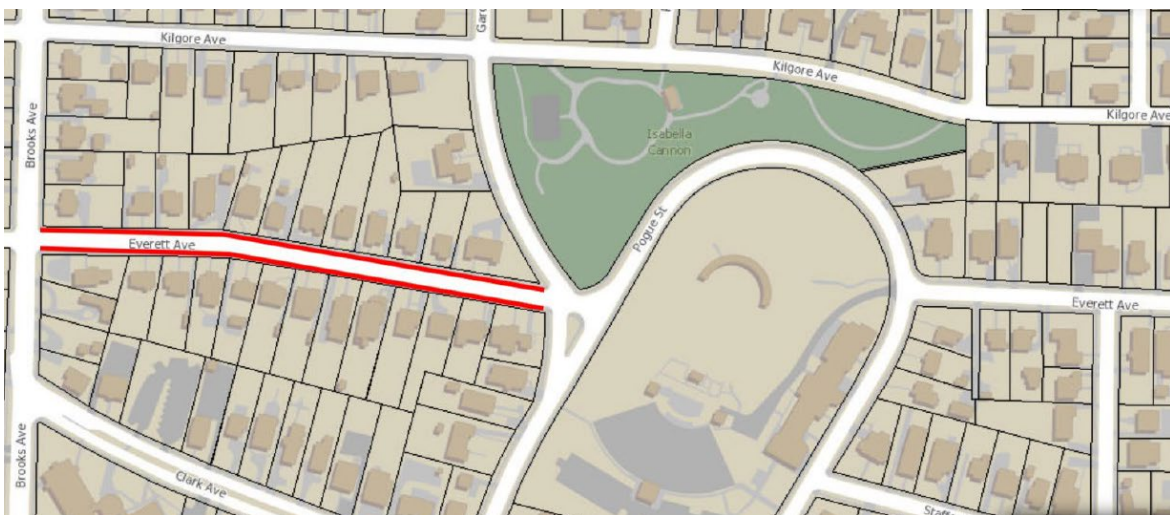

### Portion of Everett Avenue to be Closed Next Week

A portion of Everett Avenue (off Clark Avenue) will be closed starting Monday, October 21 to add a new pipe to the stormwater infrastructure in this area. The road will be closed between Brooks Avenue and Gardner Street.



Residents located on the portion of Everett Avenue to be closed will have access to their homes. Work is expected to be completed Friday, October 25, weather permitting.

Detour information as follows:

- Traffic to the west of Everett Avenue will be routed through Kilgore Avenue to Gardner Street; and,
- Traffic to the east of Everett Avenue will be routed through Kilgore Avenue to Brooks Avenue.

### Pavement Management Data Collection

As part of a continual commitment to good financial stewardship and maintenance of the street infrastructure, the Raleigh Department of Transportation (RDOT) is developing a comprehensive pavement management system. Once complete, the system will provide for the development and testing of multiple repaving and maintenance models and strategies that help prescribe the best, most cost-effective approach to maintaining city streets in good condition with improved ride quality.

Raleigh will soon see the next phase of the pavement management system development. The new system will use massive amounts of pavement condition data and staff has contracted with the ARRB Group to collect the data. Data collection begins within the next two weeks and will be relatively unobtrusive. ARRB Group will survey city streets and collect data with a special van equipped with cameras, lasers and GPS. The van will operate at speed with surrounding traffic, similar to a Google Maps camera vehicle. ARRB expects to collect data from every city street over the course of the next 10-12 weeks.

Upon completion of data collection and evaluation, a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) will be generated for each street maintained by the City. The pavement management software will also evaluate the millions of data points and help recommend the best maintenance or repair treatment for an individual street or street segment. As funding is constrained, the Pavement Management System will help determine where limited financial resources are best directed in order to benefit the overall street network. The pavement condition data will assist in the development of maintenance work plans will also be used to establish a five-year resurfacing plan.

During the October 15 City Council meeting staff provided an update on the Impact Partner Grant program. The grant program, which kicked off in January 2019, has invested in five Raleigh based organizations to date that collectively are supporting military veteran entrepreneurs, area youth innovators, underrepresented entrepreneurs and workforce talent on the autism spectrum.
