Solid Waste Services Rebalancing Routes

Solid Waste Services (SWS) collects garbage, recycling, and yard waste from more than 127,000 households in Raleigh. Garbage is collected weekly, while recycling and yard waste are collected bi-weekly.

The SWS department performs 60,000 daily service stops on average and, due to the growth of the community and the corresponding service area, periodic rebalancing of service routes is necessary to ensure efficient operations. The rebalancing process redistributes the number of homes or service stops for each existing route to ensure a balanced workload. The last time a system rebalance was performed was in 2020. Staff is developing a strategy to conduct rebalancing on a more routine basis to reduce the impact to customers.

During the month of February, SWS rebalanced the service routes. Primary goals of the rebalancing process is to keep customer service days the same and to distribute the workload more equitably among service routes. Staff believes the efforts have achieved both goals.

As routes are rebalanced, incidences of missed collections may occur as staff gains familiarity with the new routes. Our team is working hard to reduce the number of misses and continuing to tweak routes where needed. Bikeshare Station Relocation to Gipson Play Plaza at Dix Park

Transportation staff and the Gipson Play Plaza project team are working together to install a planned bikeshare station at the Gipson Play Plaza site in Spring 2025. Due to a recent assessment of usage data and existing assets, staff will relocate the existing Hillsborough Street and Royal Street bikeshare station assets to the Gipson Play Plaza project site.

An analysis of station usage over the past four years identified the Hillsborough and Royal station as a candidate for relocation to the Gipson Play Plaza, where ridership demand is expected to be higher. The relocation of this bikeshare station allows for more efficient use of existing resources.

The Hillsborough Street and Royal Street bikeshare site will be converted into the city's first permanent virtual bikeshare station. The virtual pilot bikeshare station will provide insights into operational feasibility and user experience associated with virtual bikeshare stations. The virtual station design will borrow elements from the mobility corrals that have recently been implemented along the Glenwood South corridor. This virtual station will continue to receive the same level of service as when it was a docked station. Operators will visit and maintain bikes at the same frequency, with no changes to service or maintenance due to its transition to a virtual station.

Local businesses and community stakeholders will be engaged on these upcoming changes. Mailers were sent to businesses near the station and bicycle and pedestrian advocacy groups have also been informed.

This initiative reflects the City's commitment to innovation and resourcefulness in advancing bikeshare accessibility. By strategically reallocating assets and piloting new approaches, the program aims to enhance service efficiency while continuing to support multimodal transportation goals. The relocation is scheduled for Spring 2025.
