Raleigh Water has finalized design and is actively permitting a critical waterline project to reinforce water supply to the western portion of the utility service area. Approximately 16,000 feet of new, 36-inch water transmission main will extend from the existing water system in the vicinity of the old Bain Water Treatment Plant (located on Fayetteville Street) and convey water to the Pullen Park Booster Pump Station (located on the Pullen Park property). The need for this project was previously identified in the 2016 Water System Master Plan, and a project map is included with the *Update* materials. The project is targeting a Fall 2025 construction bidding and award, with construction to start in early 2026.

A portion of the project alignment crosses the Dix Park property. The pipeline project alignment was extensively coordinated with stakeholders and determined the best option for constructability, cost, and long-term parking benefits. Dix Park will benefit from the new water main by having strategic tapping locations provided to support future parks development including access to water and fire service. Additionally, a reclaimed water line is being installed as part of the project scope; this provides the potential for a sustainable water source for Dix Park uses such as irrigation and other non-potable uses.

Coordination efforts between Raleigh Water and Parks staff have been ongoing to minimize disruptions to Dix Park operations, to best align with the Dix Park Master Plan, and to minimize disruption to trees and landscape.

Dix Park has a major public art installation taking place in October near the northwest property line of Dix Park and in the vicinity of the Pullen to Bain project.

Prior to the art installation, Raleigh Water is conducting preliminary tree removal within an existing pine grove starting August 25, with operations extending for approximately one month, to accommodate the future watermain corridor. The work will be performed by an on-call contractor with oversight by Urban Forestry staff to ensure precision while working within Dix Park. The clearing is taking place prior to the art installation to minimize disruption to the art installation and its opening. Suitable hardwoods will be salvaged for future use as public art or amenity features within Dix Park. Other trees will require removal in the future, but will not be removed until necessary to install this important water main connection.

In addition to minimizing disruption to the future art installation, precision clearing will allow the City to explore a new greenway spur that would connect Rocky Branch Trail directly with Flowers Field. This spur would potentially increase access to Dix Park from Western Boulevard, the NC State Main Campus, Pullen Park, and other destinations.


