THIRD AMENDED DECLARATION OF IMPOSITION OF CURFEW

June 4, 2020

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Emergency Proclamation issued for the City of Raleigh, North Carolina, on May 31, 2020 (the "Emergency Proclamation"), the Amended Emergency Proclamation issued on June 1, 2020 (the "Amended Emergency Proclamation") and the Second Amended Emergency Proclamation issued on June 3, 2020 (the "Second Amended Emergency Proclamation"), authority granted under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Section 1-1051 of the City of Raleigh Code of Ordinances, the Mayor may set a curfew to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property during the present State of Emergency associated with the events of civil unrest occurring in the City during the past several days.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the City of Raleigh, I, Mary-Ann Baldwin, Mayor of the City of Raleigh, North Carolina, hereby declare:

Section 1: Curfew Imposed. Pursuant to the parameters set forth in Section 3 and other provisions of the Second Amended Emergency Proclamation, a curfew is imposed between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Details regarding the curfew and exceptions shall be as declared in the Second Amended Emergency Proclamation.

Section 2: Distribution. I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with the City Clerk, and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

Section 3: Effective Date and Time. This declaration shall take effect at 2020, and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
