

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


### Alteration/Construction/Removal of exterior Stairs and Steps

Steps in the rear of the house have been removed per previously approved COA. They will be replaced with a  $12 \times 12$  wood deck painted to match the original front porch. The new deck will be centered around the new and previously approved back doors and steps down from the deck with be 10 feet wide.






Previous rear elevation.



Steps have been removed, foundation has been repaired, and folding door has been added as part of the duplex to single family conversion. New siding was used to prevent a patchy look. Original COA application for 6x6 deck was based on contractors miscaculation of how much deck would be needed to support opening of folding doors which measure 10 feet wide.
