
<u>Detailed Description and Rationales of Work</u>

- 1. Installation of (3) 30" diameter painted concrete bollards in previously approved courtyard.
 - Installing 3 precast painted concrete bollards similar to the existing one in our interior courtyard creates a visual interest point and connects the 101 S. Blount Street corner to the rest of the Marbles campus.
- 2. Design and color palette for mural to be painted on previously approved brick elevation of 105 South Blount Street.
 - The proposed design and color palette for the mural respond to community input received from hundreds of stakeholders through interviews, polls, surveys and workshops during an extensive eight-month master planning process in 2016. From civic leaders, neighbors and general public alike, Marbles heard conclusively that our community wants us to invest in re-imagining our campus exterior to reflect outside the vibrant imaginative play that takes place inside the museum walls.
- 3. Paint colors for concrete seating surfaces previously approved.
 - Applying paint to the concrete seating further demonstrates and supports community desire to reflect the Marbles mission throughout the architecture of the campus.
- 4. Paint colors for paved concrete surface of courtyard previously approved.
 - Applying paint to the courtyard surface further demonstrates and supports community desire to reflect the Marbles mission throughout the architecture of the campus.
- 5. Installation of removable color vinyl on inset metal panels in storefront alcoves, upper window frames and circular vent along Blount Street.
 - Applying color vinyl on inset metal panels in storefront alcoves, upper window frames and circular vent along Blount Street further demonstrates and supports community desire to reflect the Marbles mission throughout the architecture of the campus.
- 6. Removal of Holly bushes in (2) raised planters along Blount Street and replacement with new plant material, Hellebores.
 - Removing the large Holly bushes in the raised planters along the buildings Blount Street façade addresses public safety and cleanliness concerns. People often sleep overnight behind the bushes and store bags of clothes and other personal items unfit for public sight. Replacing the holly bushes with low plantings of Hellebores will discourage such behavior moving forward.
- 7. Paint colors for paved concrete in City of Raleigh Right of Way. (Painting of select 2x2 squares along Blount Street from 101 S. Blount to 201 E. Hargett St.) (RHDC approval to be followed by final approval from City of Raleigh Arts and Planning departments per citizens request process.)
 - Applying paint to the City of Raleigh Right of Way demonstrates and supports community desire to reflect the Marbles mission throughout the architecture of the campus.




