When the previous owner of our house built the rear addition, he put a very low sloped (2/12) roof on it. A standard shingled roof was installed. We are having some recurring water leaks and we have recommendations from three roofing companies to replace the roof with a "modified bitumen" roof made for low slope roofs.

Material selected: Flintlastic SA by CertainTeed. http://www.certainteed.com/Products/308479

Color: Moire Black

Scope of work:

- 1. Remove existing shingles, felt, and pipe flashings. Dispose of resulting debris.
- 2. Inspect and, if necessary, replace any damaged roof decking
- 3. Install white aluminum drip edge flashing at all roof perimeters. Note: existing gutters will remain in place; flashing will be fastened into gutters (where applicable).
- 4. Install rolled roof system on upper low sloped roof terminating at existing valley.
- 5. Install four box vents (2 per side) -8" model 750 roof vents (see image).

Note: Existing gutters will remain in place.
