Existing steps appear to be brick covered with smooth concrete. When trying to repair bottom two steps, the entire block pulled away from the house and shows that the steps were built over a large pile of crumbled stone & brick. We've removed and would like to pour a base of 6" concrete over rebar, cinderblock step bases capped with Phoenix brick (modular size for steps). This is a tumbled paver that we chose to compliment the Andersonville brick used in the front walk. Andersonville does not offer a step block size. Size is the same as existing steps, with a 1/2 inch overhang. Overall, the six steps measure 47" tall x 76" long x 92" wide with a 7.25" rise, 12" tread & 0.5" overhang.
