

My insurance carrier will cancel my insurance on the property if I do not comply with their request. The hand rails will be on both sides of the existing concrete stairs. They will be made from wood in a manner consistent with the existing railings around the porches. The hand rails will have identical pickets as the current porches. I will use the existing trim color that was approved by the historic district six months ago to hand paint the railings so they exactly match the existing . The material used will be nails, wood, and paint.
