Snee Application Note

We want to remove a utility chimney from our house at 516 N. Boundary St. as part of an interior renovation. (The chimney is inside a wall we want to remove.)

There is no interior fireplace connected to the chimney. It's also not being used to vent a furnace.

The chimney does not go up the side of the house; it emerges in the middle of the roof to the left of the peak (facing the front).

See attached photos for clarification.

At some point in the past it appears to have been roughly waterproofed with what looks like stucco, covering the original brick.

Our desire is to remove it entirely and roof over the spot with shingle to match the existing shingle roof.
