



Even so, it may be helpful for you to respond to my email anyway in case we need it to narrow



Oberlin Village

"In the 1860's freed slaves founded Oberlin, the largest Reconstruction-era freedmen's settlement in Wake County. By 1880 some 160 families lived in Oberlin Village. Their respect for education and religious passion led to the establishment of the Oberlin School about 1873, Latta University about 1894, Wilson Temple United Methodist Church in the late 1860's, and Oberlin Baptist Church about 1880. They buried their loved ones at Oberlin Cemetery (est. 1873), which exists 400 feet to the East/North East. "
