		Our sign is constructed with traditional sign material consisting of layered raw steel, exposed bolts, and minimal neutral colors (black & beige/gold). The sign holds the same design on the front and the back of our name, RALEIGH RAW, and our logo, a lotus flower. The lotus flower represents resilience and prosperity and is a widely recognized symbol.
		The name, RALEIGH RAW & the lotus flower are constructe out of the raw steel and painted in black. The Sign is steel painted in beige/gold with exposed bolts. The color scheme beige/gold and black is reminicent of the history of the Raleigh Building as well as the existing signage on Hargett S
		The sign is square in shape and suspended from a mounted steel frame, which is connected to a supporting wooden bea inside of the wooden exterior.
