




Raleigh Little Theatre (RLT) seeks to install a sculpture of the masks of comedy and tragedy on the exterior of the lobby to the Cantey V. Sutton Theatre. A space for such a sculpture was specifically designed in to the structure to mimic the exterior of the theater's original façade. Currently, it is an empty space covered by a piece of plywood.

The carving, designed and executed by Paris Alexander, will be in limestone, mounted on steel plate which is then bolted to brick wall in existing alcove. 
