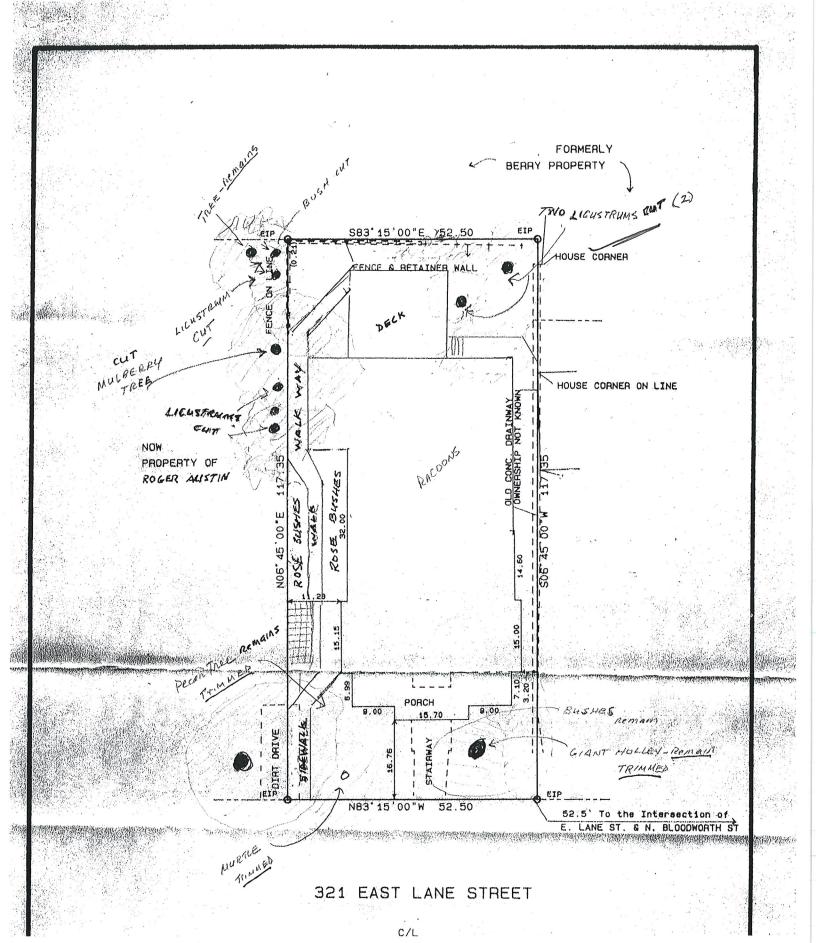

Bartlett Tree Experts recommends that on the properties of Betsy Buford & Donald Mathews at 321 E. Lane St. and of Roger Alston at 319 E. Lane St. that 6 seedling ligustrums and 1 mulberry be removed due to ongoing repairs they have to do to their house. These trees are easy access for raccoons and other wildlife to enter onto their roof and house and cause major damage. They have pruned them for years, but they grow significantly fast so it's an ongoing issue. Three of them are within 1 foot of their house on the property of Roger Alston at 319 E. Lane St. and heavy winds could cause them to hit the house and cause damage. These trees are invasive not ornamental trees.

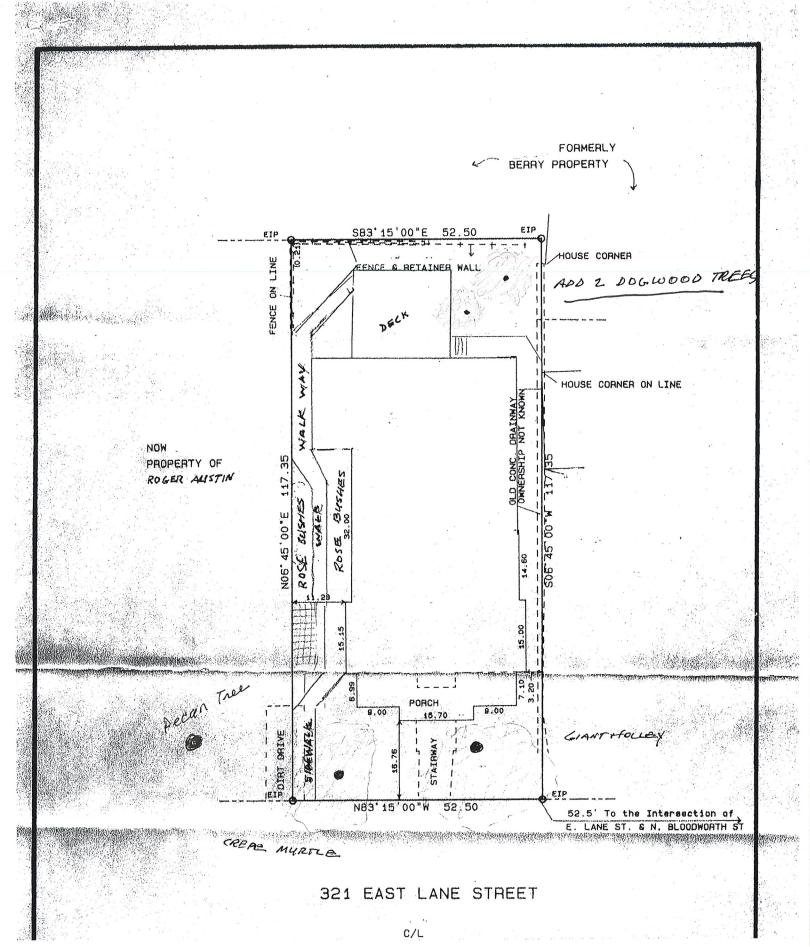

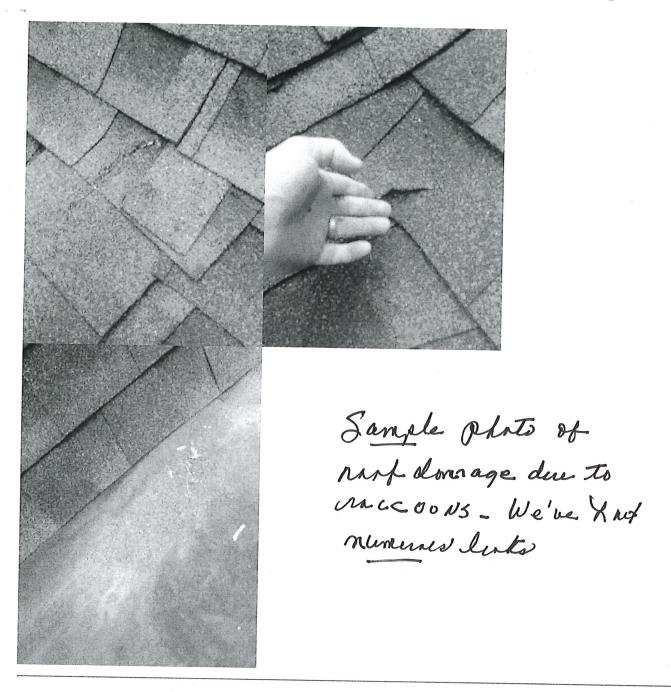


TREES REMAINS & INSTALLED 321 ELANE BUFORD-MATHEWS



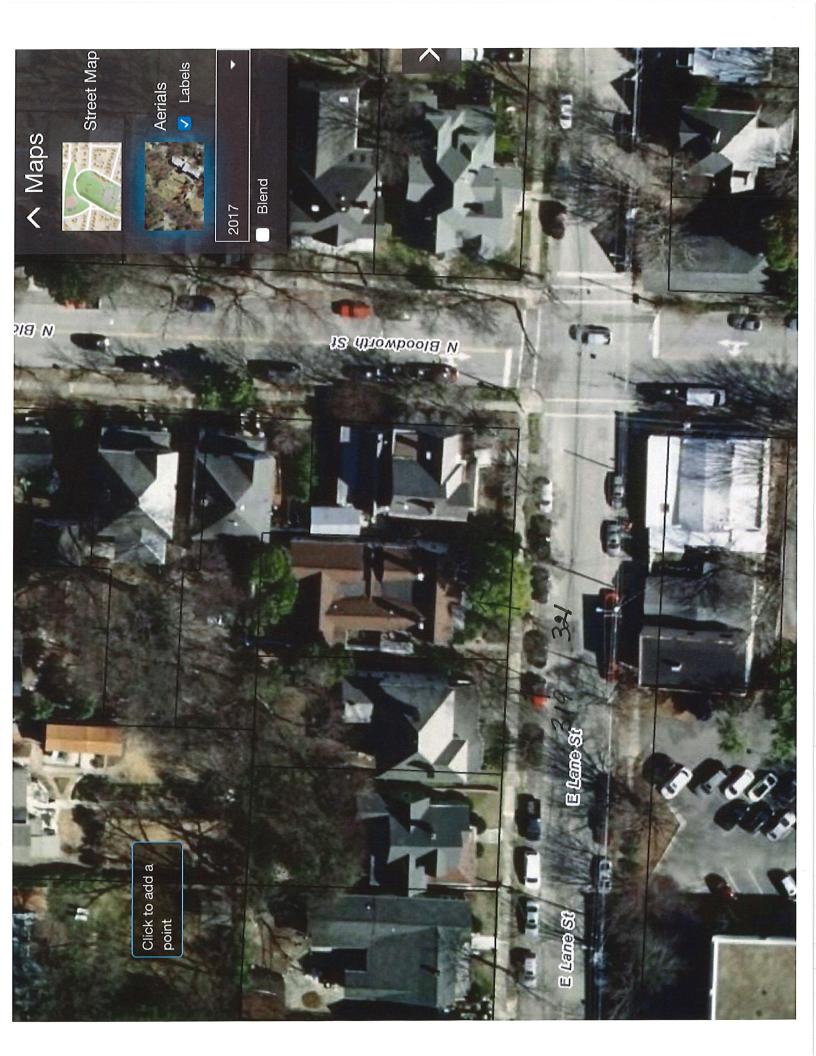
