Hi Tania,

Thank you for getting back to me. I hope the attached photos work better for you. The existing porch ceiling is sheet rock painted white, definitely not historic. There are no existing gutters which is why the homeowner's porch columns are rotting. The house was built as infill in about 1985...it has Masonite siding for example (not at all historic). I do not have a product sheet on the gutters we want to install but they will be 4" or 6" seamless aluminum (white). The houses next door to this one (also infill from same builder) have similar gutters that were installed after construction for the same reason.
