I have also added the two small trees and fork on the larger pecan that we spoke about with the thought that it would be efficient to do them at the same time assuming you may be installing plantings along the rear property line to screen the prison hospital. ITEM 1/ large dead black cherry (located at the left rear corner of the property). Our crew will being in a small aerial lift to facilitate the careful removal of this free in sections. The stump will be cut as low as possible. We will need latitude in case the rear fence is damaged due to the unpredictable condition of dead trees. Also, our crew may need to disassemble the fire pit and move the seating to gain additional space for debris. During my site visit on 8/15/2017, I observed two large, dead trees that present potential danger due to falling branches and/or full tree fall.

A large, dead black cherry tree is located in the left rear corner of your property and a large dead pecan along the middle south property line. I recommend that both be removed as they present a safety concern. Dead trees are often unpredictable, and I highly recommend removal




