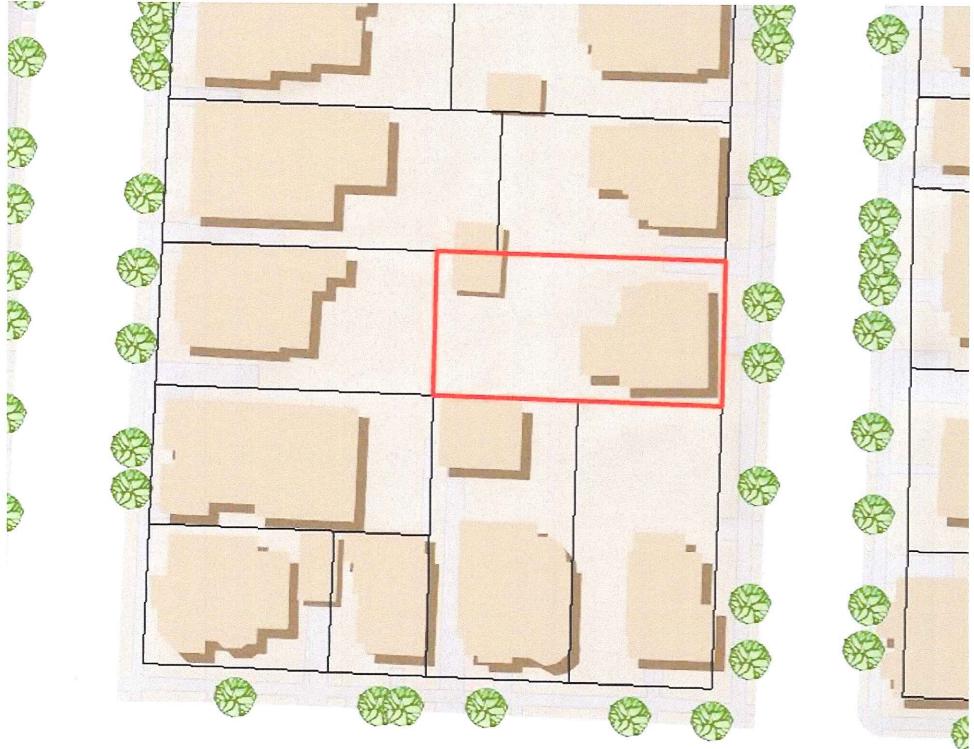

103 East St Minor Work Application Description

We are proposing to remove a non-historic exterior side door from the current mudroom. In this same room we are proposing to remove the small non-historic small double hung window with a larger wood window to match the adjacent window in the current laundry area. See photoshop elevations attached. Along with these changes, we are also proposing to demo a utility chimney that exists on the interior rear wall of the kitchen to create a more functional space, add a pair of wood patio doors on the rear elevation of mudroom, add a new window on the second floor landing of the stair where there is evidence one use to exist, and a new shed in the location where the original shed was placed when the house was built (see 1909 Sanborn map).

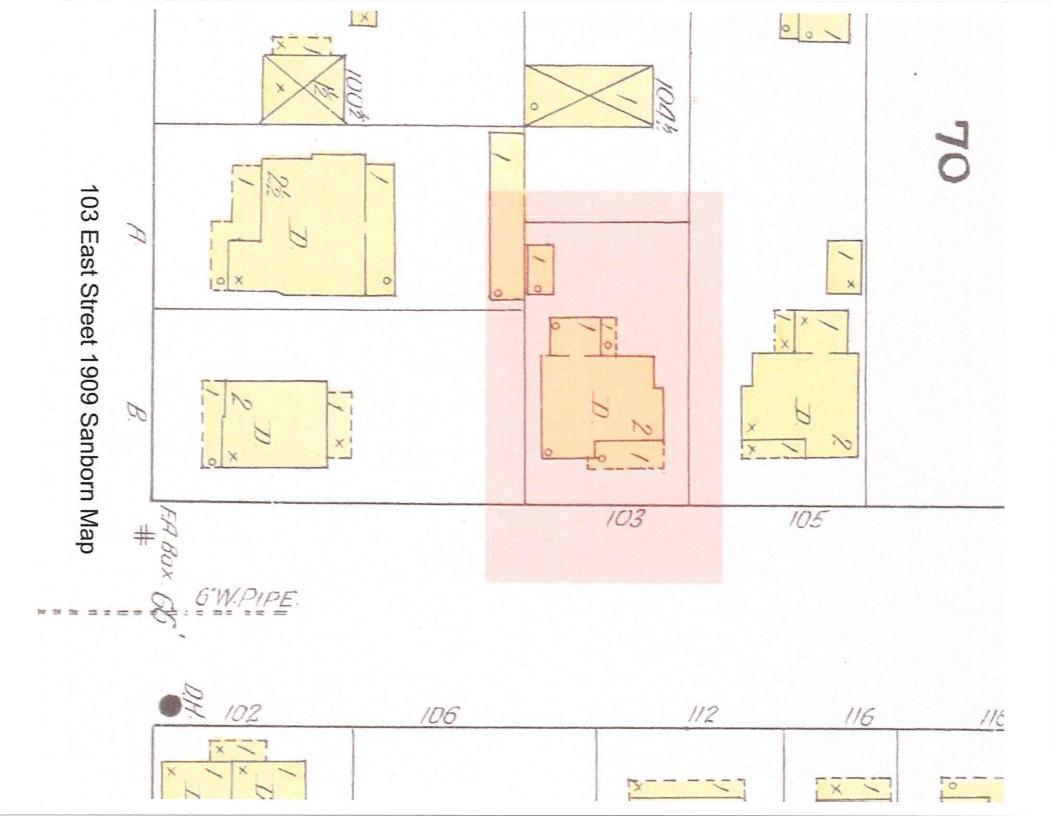
New windows to be Jeldwen Siteline Ex with site built trim to match the historic trim. Siding that will be used to fill in the side exterior door that will be removed will match existing in material, exposure (4.5" exposure), and finish. New patio doors to be Jeldwen wood patio doors that will be painted and trim will be site built to match the historic door trim existing on the house.

The new shed will be 9'x10' wood frame, wood floor, hardie siding (artisan series, smooth face similar exposure to historic house) + trim, and brick pier construction. Brick stairs will be built to accommodate the grade and finish floor height difference. Footings will be hand dug near any roots from neighboring trees. The shed takes it aesthetic from the historic house in form, roof shape, closed soffits, siding exposure, trim size and attic vents. The pair of exterior doors specifications are attached.

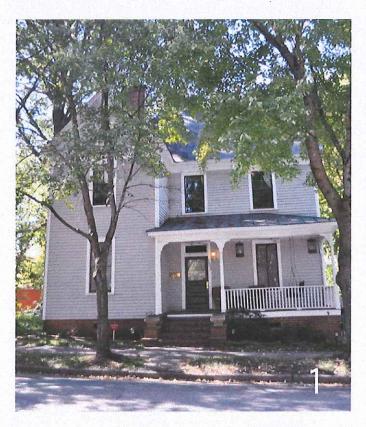

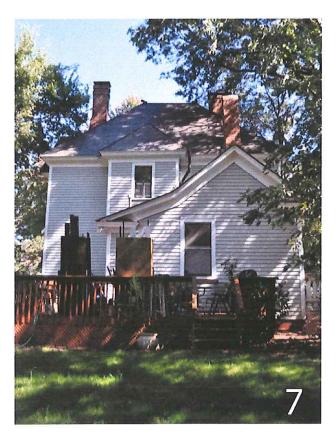




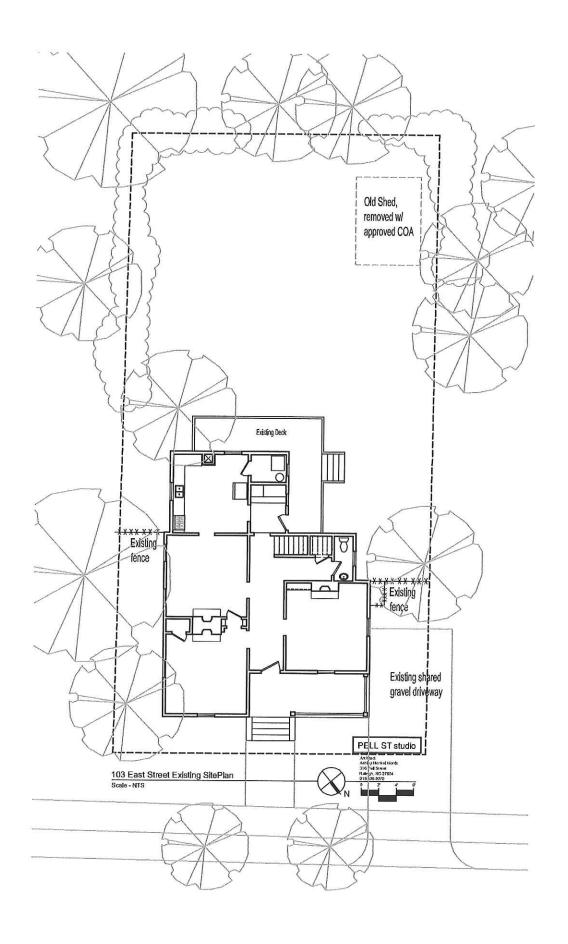


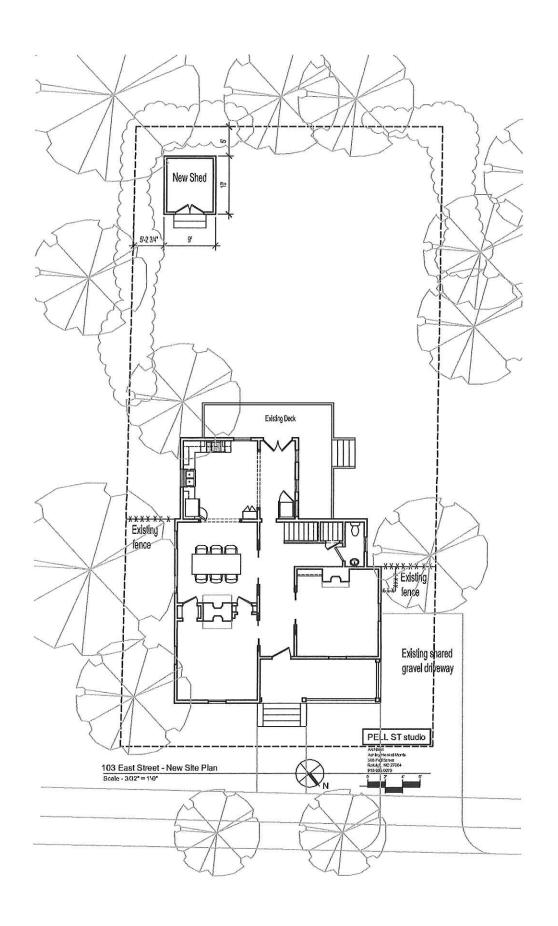


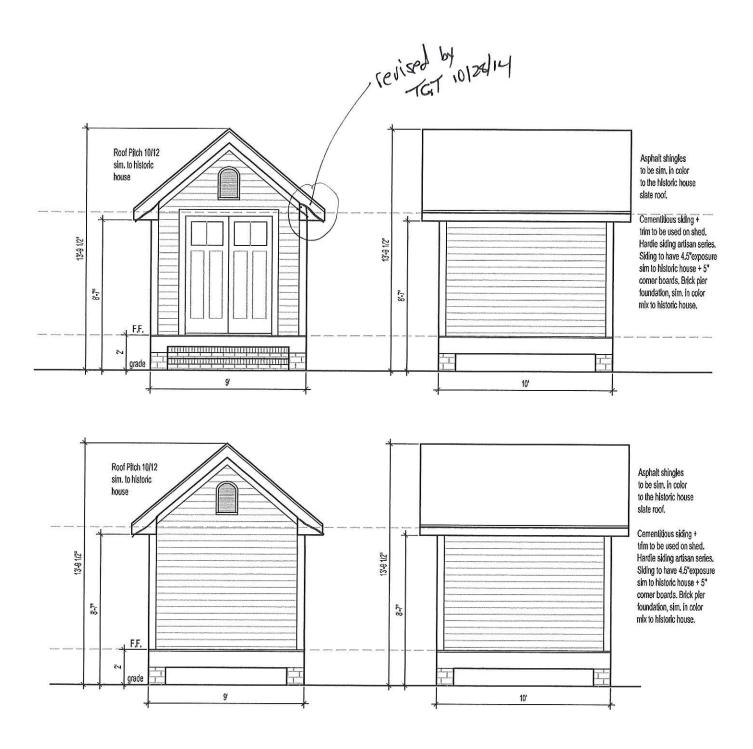


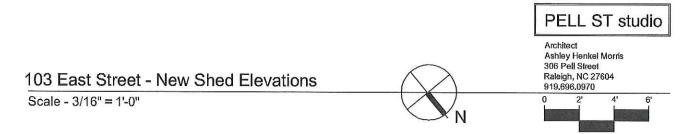


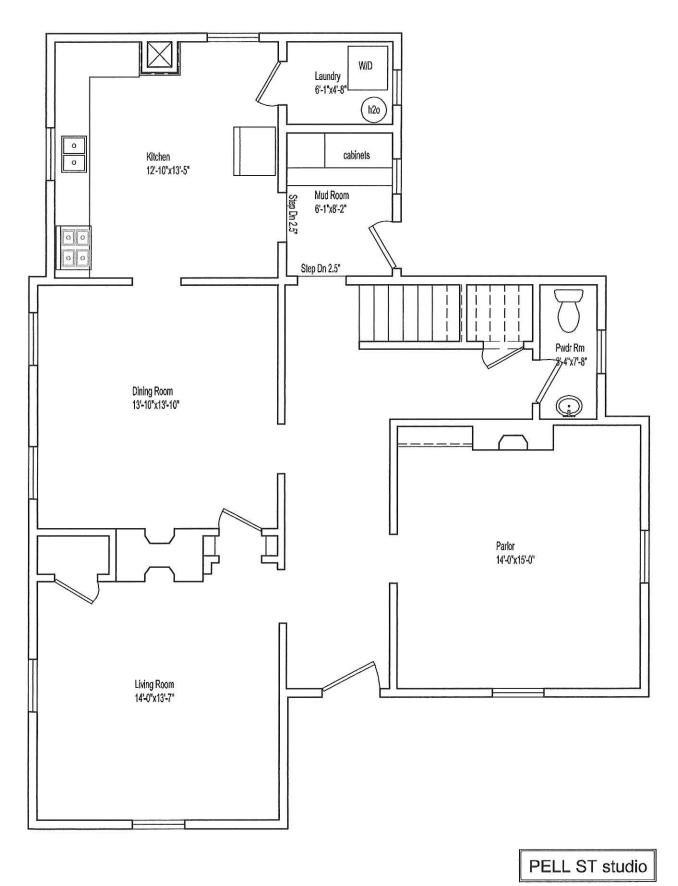












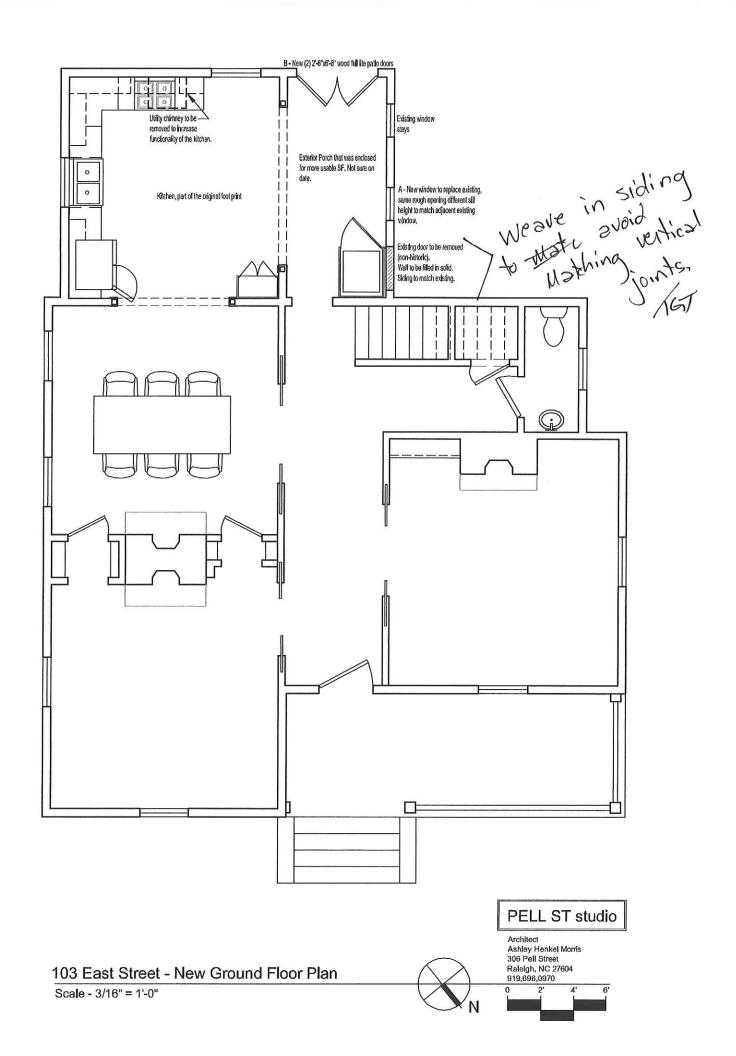
103 East Street Existing Ground Floor Plan

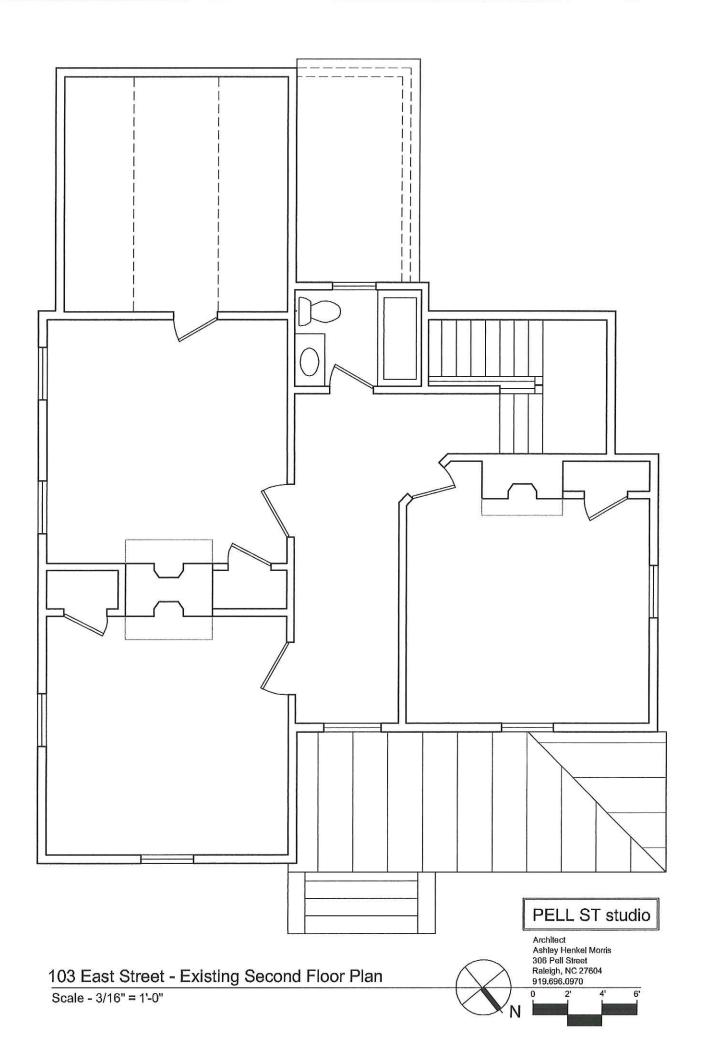

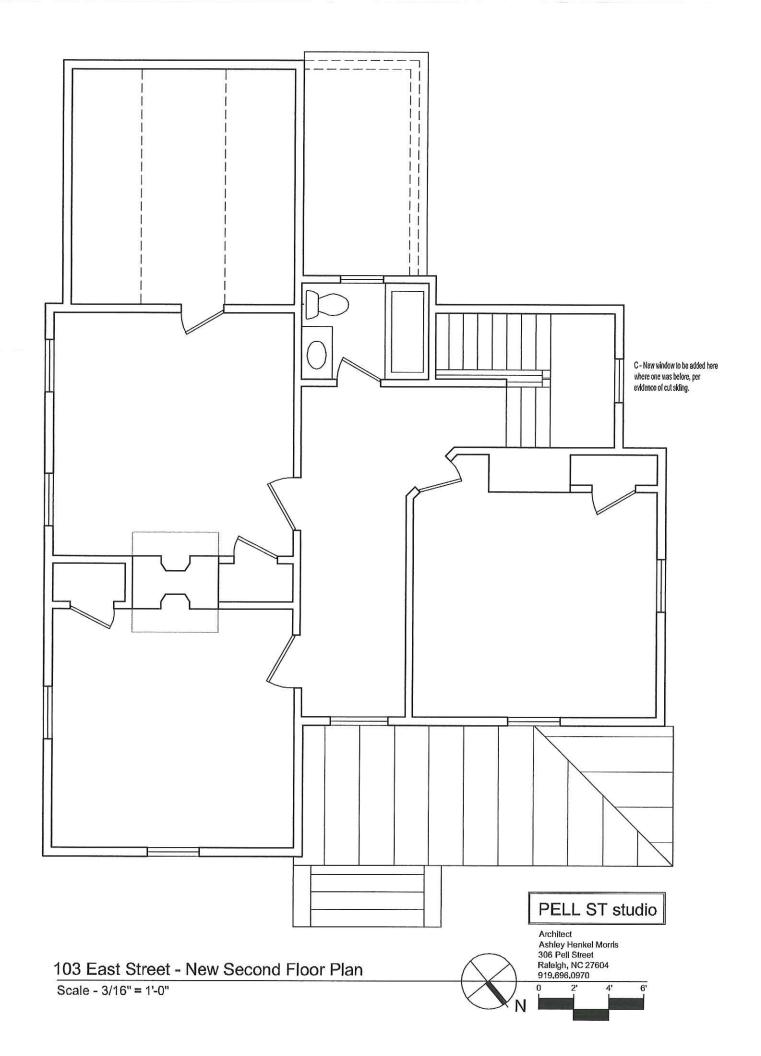






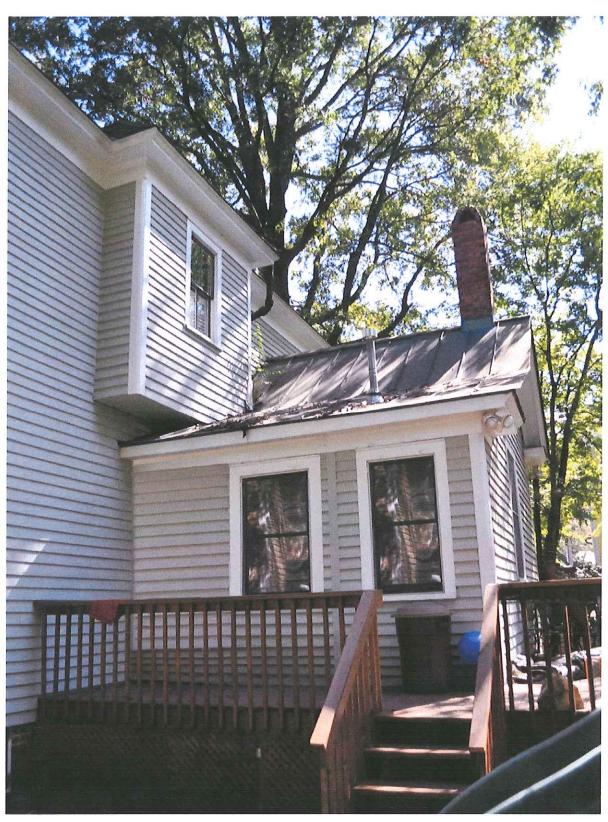




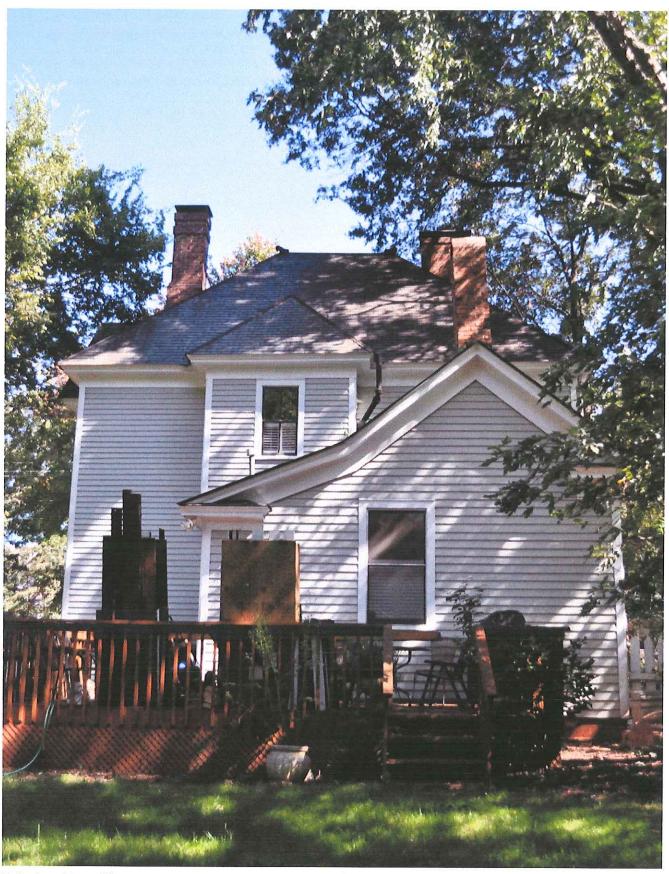




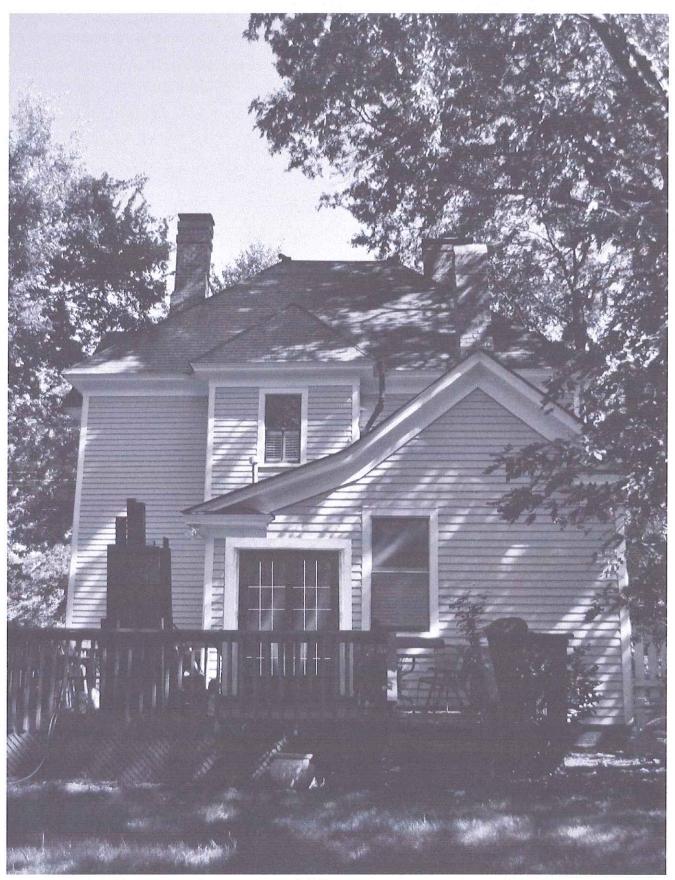
Existing Elevation of Mudroom + Laundry Room - door to be removed and small window to be replaced by a larger window to match laundry room window. More consistent appearance



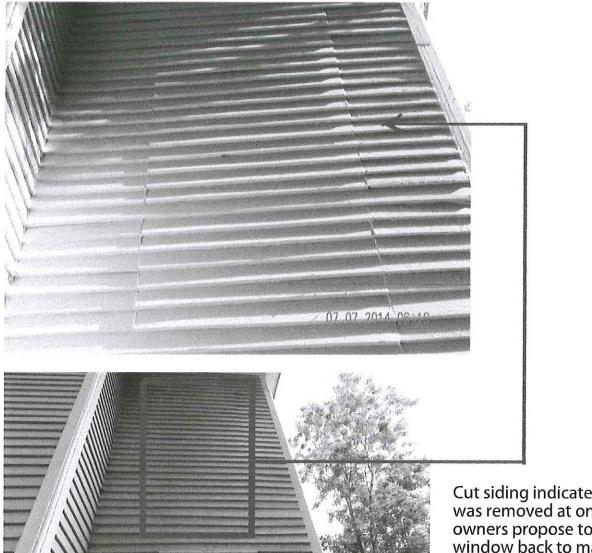
New Elevation of Mudroom - (photoshop image)



Existing Rear Elevation, interior construction debris on porch



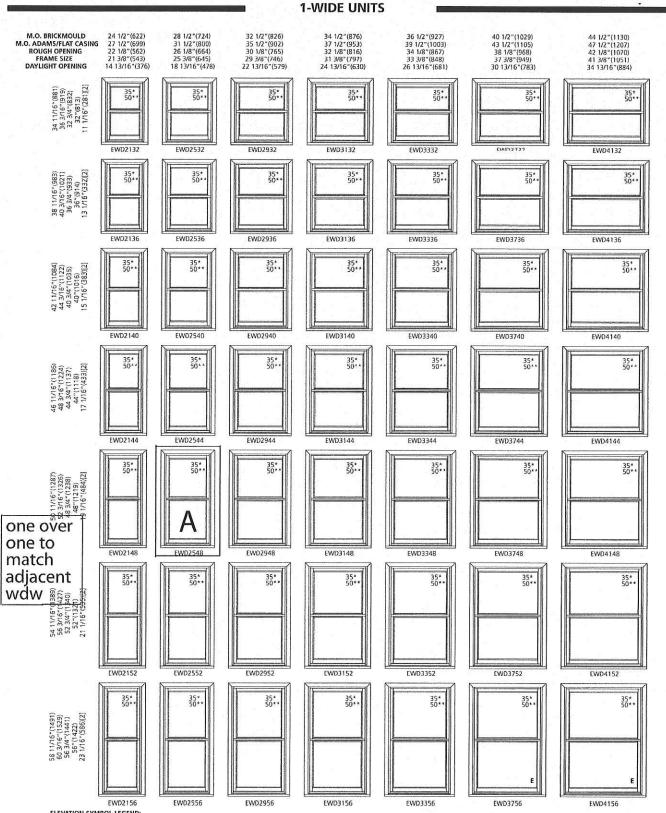
New Rear Elevation, showing two full lite patio doors - (photoshop image)

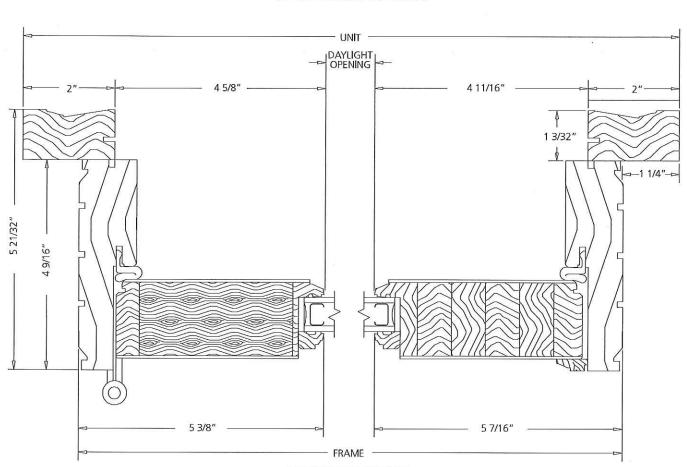
