To whom it may concern:

I have done a superficial visual inspection of the 13" 2-stemmed Redbud in the front right of the property at 415 S. Boylan Ave in Raleigh, NC. The tree old damage to the top of the larger stem. A sounding of the tree revealed that a significant percentage of the tree is hollow, making it at risk of failure.

The deterioration of tree makes it probable that large parts of the tree will fail and possible that the entire tree will fail, with some likelihood of impact to the house on the property. Based on this, I recommend removing the tree as soon as possible.
