Mount network box in the crawlspace of the Pope Building using an entry point behind/adjacent the existing exterior HVAC units per COA Guidelines 1.10 Utilities

We will run the conduit of the directional boring from a 90-degree elbow and go underneath into the crawl space. From there we will place the exterior Box for the Fiber Slack. This will allow us to mount the box in the crawl space out of sight.

We will gain access to the crawlspace with a small penetration point through the brick pointing estimating the hole to be 2" or less in diameter using a new hole or an existing hole in the current pointing.
