
**Description of Improvement:** Installation of 31 solar photovoltaic modules at 415 N. Boundary St. Raleigh, North Carolina 27604 in Oakwood Historic District by Southern Energy Management. All 31 solar modules to be installed on the flat, rear roof deck with no street visible modules. All attachments and wiring to be concealed under modules. Equipment installed is to be all black in nature and flush mounted to roof deck. Individual modules are 4 x 5.7 feet. Contractor will provide all permits and complete all necessary inspections for the authority having jurisdiction.
