






Photo 1 - Front - 513 Polk St, Raleigh NC 27604

COA-0028-2021 Conditions of Approval:

- 1 That the applicant receive, prior to commencement of the work, all other required permits or permissions from governmental agencies;
- 2 That any revisions or deviations to any portion of the as-submitted work shall be submitted to staff prior to installation or construction for review and approval.
- 3 That any new post holes be dug manually and tree roots larger than 1" caliper that are encountered while digging the fence post holes shall receive a clean final cut using tools designed for the purpose, such as loppers.
