

Exterior

- 1. Scrape and sand all peeling areas
- 2. Power wash entire house
- 3. Caulk all joints and cracks
- 4. One coat of primer on siding, trim, windows, doors, front porch railings, columns, porch ceiling
- 5. One coat of paint on siding, trim, windows, doors, front porch railings, columns, porch ceiling, and previously painted areas of rear deck and rear porch
- Two coats of flat stain on deck including rear steps, exterior of lattice, rear porch floor, underside of rear porch, and basement threshold
