223 Elm Street -- COA Application -- Written Descriptions

Shed

We'd like to build a 6'Wx8'Lx12'H shed at the back left of our property. This would require leveling the space, building a retaining wall on three sides, and constructing the shed. Photos of the current area are attached.

Materials/Design. See the attached plans. It would be under 144sq feet. The shed colors (blue with white trim) and materials would match our house.

Gate

Between the property of 218 N. East Street and our home on 223 Elm there is a brick fence with steps leading to the backyard of the 218 N. East house. We'd like to install a 4x4 privacy fence between the spaces.

See the attached photos of what it currently looks like as well as the attached photo of the style of fence we'd like to install. The gate would be made of wood and would be white.

Deck

We'd like to add a 4'Wx6.5'Lx8"h addition to our deck. We'd use brazilian ipe (same as our main deck) for this extension and it would be supported and finished exactly the same as the main deck. See the attached photos of the proposed area for the deck extension.
