1. Written Description (previously submitted)

Modify the rear section of house to 2 stories and tie new roof into roof of the main part of the house. Expand the foundation footprint slightly as shown in the Survey and Drawings. The rear stairway that is damaged and does not currently meet Code will be replaced for safety and to provide egress from the upstairs units. The stairway will be accessed from the upstairs via the existing door and a covered landing underneath the roof.

A small deck will be built in the rear of the house with approximate dimensions of 13' by 17.' It will be at the level of the $1^{\rm st}$ floor and will be completely behind the house. The entire house will be repainted including siding, trim, doors and windows. Central AC will be added. Condensing units will be placed at the side of the house and will be obscured from view from the street by lattice work. All windows will have metal or aluminum storm windows added to improve energy efficiency and durability.
