Project Summary:

This COA application seeks approval for the following:

- Changes to front yard landscaping (north elevation) and side yards (east and west elevations) to better suit light/growing conditions. Proposed changes to include:
 - -- Removal of six boxwoods (ca. 2014) along the curtain wall (north elevation), replacing with a pair of clethra flanking the steps, as well as perennials, annuals, bulbs, groundcover, and hypericum frondosum, more suitable for existing light/growing conditions. Additional care will be taken when hand-digging shrubs so as not to disturb the roots of the existing Japanese maple;
 - Installation of a stepping stone path in front yard's east side;
 - Removal of hydrangea (ca. 2014 east elevation), replacing with an Illicium;
 - Removal of what are largely weeds, and replacing with Lysimachia nummularia along the east elevation;
 - Groundcover installation in the median beds; and
 - Removal of existing Rosa banksiae on west elevation's arbor and fence due to structural destabilization of such, replacing with less vigorous climbing rose.
