Dear RHDC Staff,

We are preparing to repaint our home at 516 Polk Street in Oakwood. For this effort, we are replacing a small amount of deteriorated wood siding, and the original front door which is beyond repair. A new front door has been custom-built to match the style, panel layout, and glazing of the original front door. However, the old-growth pine material could not be matched so we are planning to paint the replacement instead of staining. The need to paint the front door is the primary reason for the minor work COA application. Secondarily, we are removing a non-contributing storm door on the front of the home and not planning to replace it with another storm door.

When repainting the home, we will use the same scheme and all colors approved by COA many years ago. The one change will be the addition of a new color for the front door. This week, I will deliver to your office the paint color chips along with a copy of the application documents submitted via the City's portal for your convenient reference.

Thank you for confirming receipt of the envelope and paint samples. Yes, I can verify that the replacement door is a custom-built replica of the original save the following details:

- Wood species is different hence the need to paint.
- Two decorative trim pieces on the exterior of the door. These details will be removed from the original door and
 installed on the new door prior to painting to provide a visual twin.

Please see the attached pictures and note the doc is three pages. On the second page, there are notes that should help explain the accent detail mentioned above.




