





Hey Erin,

I'm just getting around to updating the minor work COA for 1010 W Cabarrus. I uploaded some additional photos onto the portal showing the exterior prior to painting. We probably replaced 8-10 siding boards on the east, 4 boards on the west, 7 boards on the north, and 0 on the south. We replaced some trim around the front column bases to match as well as some trim around one window on the westside and one door on the northside. All glass replacement was original wavy glass. I'll swing by and drop off the requested paint schedule and samples later this week.
