Removal of Unsafe Maple Tree

This application for a certificate of appropriateness is to request approval for removal of a dangerous tree and a replacement with a similar tree. The tree in question is a maple tree approximately 25 years old which has developed a split in the trunk. The tree is located on the southeast corner of the property, on the corner of East Jones and North Bloodworth Streets (Figure 1). The tree is located between the sidewalk and the front porch, and is planted within the lot. A certified arborist, Jared Kibbe, from Bartlett Tree Experts has evaluated the tree, and provided a report (a copy is attached). He has indicated that a large stem crack has formed in the main union of the upper canopy and is travelling down the tree, and that the tree is at risk of falling onto our property, power lines, and the street. We propose to have the tree removed as soon as possible, have the stump ground out, and replace the tree with a similar tree (a maple or similar).






Figure 2. Crack in the trunk of the maple tree from the western side.

Photographs of the tree, its location next to the house, and adjacent power lines are provided below Figures 2-6. .




Figure 4. View of upper branches looking east along Jones St.
