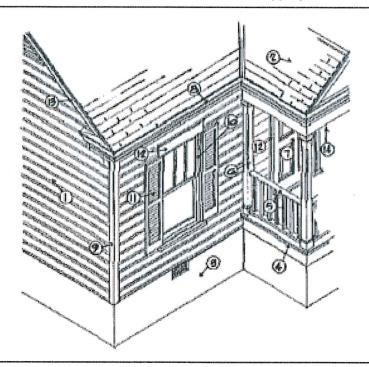

- -All required covering, prep work, caulking, scrapping/sanding, & spot priming
