


- 1) Remove metal fence along driveway

  - c. The fence will be removed by a licensed contractor
  - d. Existing fence pictures attached

  - a. 4x4 wood posts, 3/4x6 pickets spaced 1.5" apart, capped style on top
  - b. Will be stained gray at a later date and color sample can be provided
  - c. Proposed wood fence picture below





On March 6, 2023 ISA Certified Arborist Patrick Munley reviewed the trees and site plan for the demolition of the shed at 410 N. East Street. His findings and recommendations are below.





There are six trees on the site, depicted on the survey map with their critical root zones. All six are in good health for their age and species.

In my professional opinion, the proposed work will have little to no impact on the trees directly surrounding the shed at the back left that is slated for removal. In order to reduce stress to the trees, I would recommend a compost tea fertilization for the trees post demolition. I can provide a quote for this service at a later date.
