

- 1) SURFACE PREPARATION ALL WOODEN SURFACES TO BE CLEANED
- 2) SURFACE PREPARATION ALL WOODEN SURFACES TO BE HAND SANDED OR HAND SCRAPED TO REMOVE LOOSE PAINT
- 3) PRIME + CAULK EXPOSED SURFACES TO BE PRIMED WITH EXTERIOR PRIMER + JOINTS REACAULKED [EXPECT HORIZONTAL LAP SEAM OF CLAPBOARD SIDING]
- 4) PAINT PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES TO BE PREPAINTED WITH COMPATIBLE PAINT
- 5) EXISTING UNPAINTED BRICK FOUNDATION TO REMAIN UNPAINTED, EXISTING PAINTED LATTICE TO BE PAINTED




