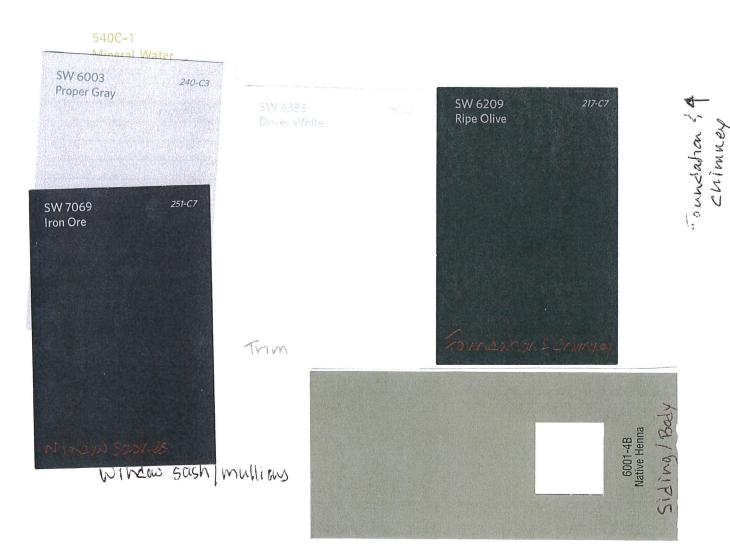

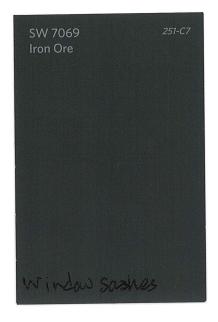

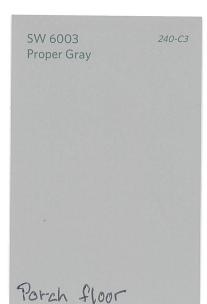
- 1. All surfaces will be washed to remove dirt, mildew, moss, loose paint
- 2. Rotten wood will be repaired or replaced to match original, may include siding, fascia boards, flying rafters and corbels.
- 3. All surfaces will be scraped, caulked and primed prior to application of two coats of paint or stain.
- 4. Masonry foundation and chimney will be washed, scraped, primed and painted.
- 5. Outbuilding will be washed to remove dirt, mildew. Siding and trim will be painted to match house.



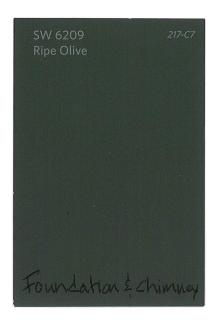
