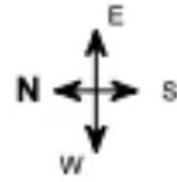
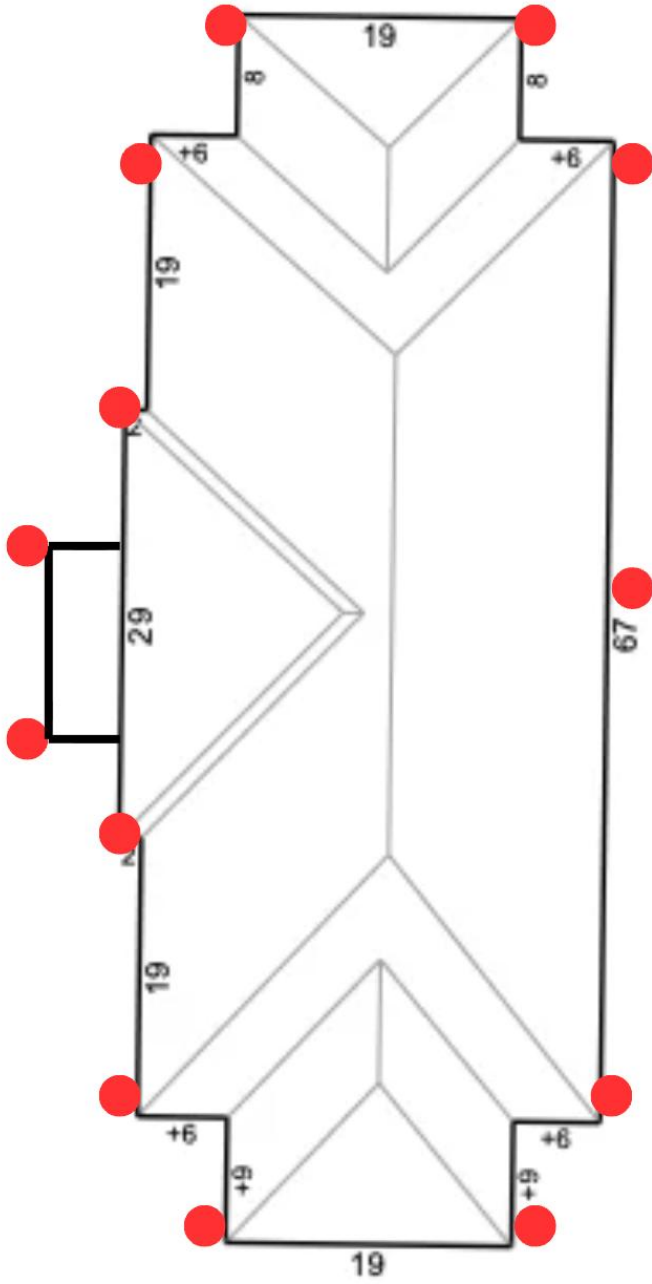


Alu-Rex Double Pro
