This application serves to request approval for new gutters to be installed on 534 N. East St, Raleigh NC 27604. This home has no existing gutters. K-style gutters will be installed into the exposed rafter tails as high as possible to expose as much of the rater tail as possible, while still providing adequate slope to effectively move water. The gutters will be dark bronze in color, which is similar to many homes within Oakwood. Downspouts to be round.
