Our homeowners insurance is requiring us to repaint our exterior due to peeling paint.

We are replacing the colors with a blue-gray scheme. All colors noted are by Sherwin-Williams. The main color will be Granite Peak a blue/gray. The porch, foundation, and window sashes will be a darker blue-gray called Cyberspace. The current white features will remain white, but be refreshed with a coat of Pure White.

The balance of main color, dark accent, and white accents will remain keeping with historical accuracy.






