

Any other photographs you would like to include to help us gain a better understanding of the rear yard context is appreciated.

It appears that the hot tub area may be completely screened from the front yard by existing fencing? Is this the case? Please provide a photo looking toward the front yard from the proposed hot tub area. Finally, please provide details on the hot tub installation itself - what are the proposed dimensions? Thank you.
