First Baptist, Salisbury Street, proposes adding a sign with acrylic letters and a stylized rose window to the rear elevation of the church's 1970s rear education building. The congregation also proposes adding a frame into which art pieces can be set, also on the rear elevation of the 1970s portion of the church.

The project is confined entirely to the rear, non-character-defining elevation of the complex and will not affect or involve the church's 1859 sanctuary building. This meets guideline 1.8.2.

The sign and frame are large, but they are proportional to the rear elevation's wall planes, meeting guideline 1.8.3.

Finally, the sign does not obscure architectural features or historic features of the building, meeting guideline 1.8.8.

Answers from the sign company:

The letters will be stud mounted. We can arrange that they are mounted into the mortar rather than the brick.

The banner frame will also be fastener mounted (masonry screws), and then the fasteners covered with the frame. We will do our absolute best to avoid brick and fasten into mortar only.

And just to make sure it was clear: artwork printed on a banner is what will go inside the frame, with only the frame being mounted to the wall.

Sarah,

Thanks for submitting a minor work COA for First Baptist Church. The information for the sign and frames themselves and their scale on the overall building façade is very helpful. The one other thing we need information on is how the frame will be attached to the rear wall. A few written sentences describing the type, size, and location of fasteners and their installation through mortar joints rather than through the face of the brick should suffice.

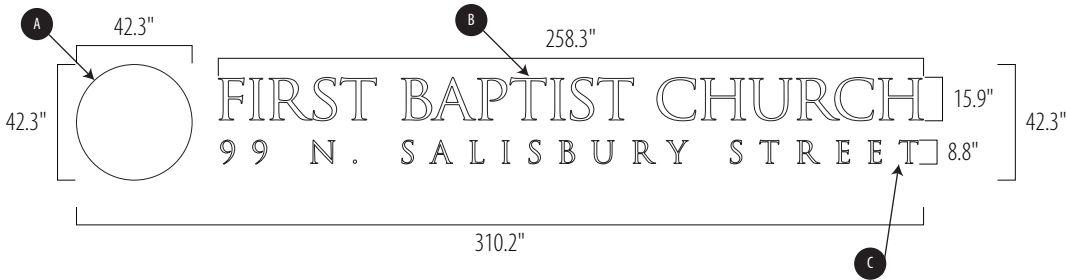

C: 3/8" white acrylic lettering, stud mounted flush to fascia



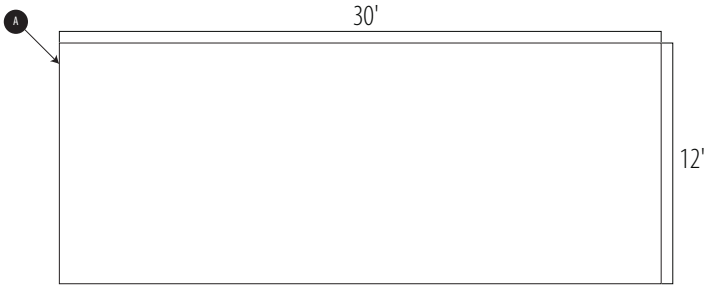

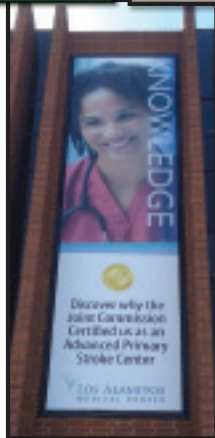
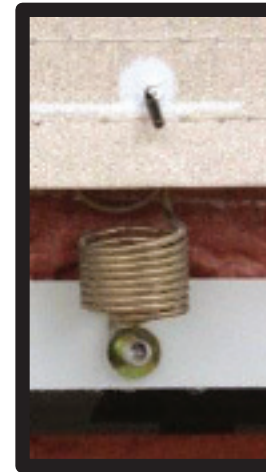
