Description of Work:

14' of wooden (pine) fencing with a gate to be added at the bottom of the driveway to completely fence in the backyard. (Other three sides are already fenced in.) Fence will be 42" tall and in the garrison style to match the North and West runs of fencing. The 4x4 posts will be finished with black Cape May caps. The 4' walking gate will match the gate already present on the North side of the house.
