


Generator placement

Install the generator in the rear corner of the house and cover it with landscaping to include 7 soft touch hollies (2 gallons – will mature at 36-42"') existing crepe myrtles between the 2 property lines and lower plantings of 3 hydrangeas (5 gallon maturing at 2')

Size- outdoor unit is 48" long, 25" wide and 29" tall and is off white in color

Unit will sit on a standard mechanical pad – composite material 2" think same size as the generator off white in color


