We hired Sigmon Construction, well regarded for their work in historic renovation, to do our house renovation. We have asked them to include painting the exterior of our house, to include the relocation of our side porch, which was approved by RHDC in September.

We are following the "Period Purist" model, we found in a This Old House article, "Paint Colors for Victorian Houses." We are using Benjamin Moore colors, several of which are from their historic collection.

We are hoping to begin preparation in the next few weeks, in November, when construction of the relocation of the porch is completed.

I have included photos of that show paint colors on all four faces of our house, the RHDC paint schedule, and BM paint swatches. I also dropped off physical copies of the schedule and swatches at your office today.


