### Repainting of Trim, Foundation and Wooden Fencing - Change of Existing Colors

The entirety of the exterior trim, including the front and side porches/decks, will be prepped and painted. In addition, the brick and cement foundation and exterior border fencing will be painted. The existing trim colors will be changed from its current darker cream and gray to a brighter cream and gray. Please note that the color change does not apply to the siding, which will remain its existing purple.

### **Trim**

All exterior trim will be cleaned and prepped for painting.

- All loose and unstable paint will be removed via scraping and/or sanding.
- Any holes and joints will be filled/repaired, as needed.
- Any raw or exposed wooden surfaces will be primed and painted.

New primary trim color: Simply White OC-117 by Benjamin Moore New secondary (detail) trim color: Cumulus Cloud 1550 by Benjamin Moore

### **Foundation**

The current foundation (brick and cement plaster over brick) has previously been painted and will be cleaned and prepped for new paint.

- All loose and unstable paint will be removed via scraping and/or sanding.
- Surfaces will be primed (as needed) and painted.

New foundation color: Cumulus Cloud 1550 by Benjamin Moore


### **Fencing**

The existing wooden picket fence around the border of the property will be cleaned and prepped for painting. Please note that the painting only applies to the existing wooden picket fence, not the existing metal border fencing or brick fencing.

- All loose and unstable paint will be removed via scraping and/or sanding.
- Any rotten or damaged wood will be repaired or replaced with same materials, as needed.
- All wooden surfaces will be primed and painted.
