Hi Marie,

Thank you for submitting a minor work COA application. We have begun the review and need a few additional items in order to consider the application complete. Please provide a photo of the full front building façade from the street. Please also fill out the attached paint schedule and mail physical paint samples for the project to: City of Raleigh, Attn: Historic Preservation Division, One Exchange Plaza, PO Box 590, Raleigh, NC 27602-0590.

Painted signs were common in the historic districts and can be approved. However, the sign should be simple in design to match the character of the existing building. Please provide a new rendering with straight lettering fitted fully within the existing parapet (above the adjacent lower roof lines.) The text size may need to be scaled down slightly to accommodate this. We also ask that you strongly consider locating the "By Appt Only" image on the entry doors themselves, whether by vinyl decal or other preferred method – it does not have to be painted.

Please let us know if you have any questions and we will keep an eye out for the paint samples. Thank you.
