Here follows a written description of the proposed signage for 501 S Person St.

Sign 1: Non illuminated single sided 1/8" ACM panels mounted to existing structure/arch with 6 1" diameter x 1" deep tamper proof standoffs. Panel to be white ACM masked and painted in Flat Black, with PVC letters in Gloss White and Sheeted Gold.

Sign 2: Non illuminated double sided 1/8" ACM panels mounted on black painted bracket into the façade above front door. Pnel to be white ACM mask and painted in Flat Black, with PVC letters in Gloss White and Sheeted Gold.







Desi,

Thank you for following up. Raised lettering and the PVC material type are not approvable as a minor work at the staff level. The intricate design at the four corners of the sign are also not approvable as a minor work as they do not clearly meet the RHDC's <u>Design Guidelines</u>. *Guideline* 1.8.4 states "Introduce new signs, including graphics for windows or awnings, that are easily read and of simple design..."

Any work request that does not clearly meet the Design Guidelines is required to be reviewed by the COA Committee. There are two options for handling the application: 1. the current building-mounted sign design may be folded into the pending major work for the COA Committee to review; or 2. you are able to suggest an alternate design to satisfy the minor work staff comments. Please let us know by this Friday's application deadline how you would like to proceed.

In terms of suggested alternate designs, staff refrains from prescribing any one specific thing you should submit, but we also want to make sure we are providing parameters, guidance, and examples of what is likely to be approvable work. We do not want you to spend time putting together an alternate design that we know will not be approvable. Hence, installing a flat-faced sign is a requirement for minor work approval, but using vinyl sticker lettering is just one suggestion of how to accomplish that. Please let us know if any further clarification is needed or if you have additional questions. Thank you.

Hope you're doing well today. I have a couple of questions/responses to the comments here.

Can I get a hard clarification on whether or not we can have raised letters? Is this a suggestion or a "suggestion"?

Our client is worried that they will lose much-needed impact and visual sophistication if they are to reduce the sign to flat vinyl on a single color background. Is there any way we can meet in the middle and have 1 or the other of these items? Given this choice, we would very much prefer to keep the dimensional letters.

Once we've got this clarified we can send the sample material within a day or two. Thank you for your insight.

Desi,

At your request, we have removed the arch-mounted sign from the minor work application and completed review of the propose building-mounted sign. The overall sign size, bracket mount, and location is approvable. The white detailing at the sign corners is atypical of the historic district. The background color should be uniform. Additionally, we are not able to approve the PVC lettering at the minor work staff level. Signs in the historic district were typically painted and did not have raised lettering. Would you consider an alternate flat-sign application, such vinyl sticker, traditional paint, or other film application? We are open to other suggestions that would achieve this effect.

I apologize for forgetting to note this sooner, but we require the review of physical paint samples in order to make sure they closely match the digital coloring shown in the application. Depending on the metallic finish of the gold lettering, the proposed colors may be approvable. Please mail physical paint samples for the proposed sign to: City of Raleigh, Planning and Development Department, Attn: Historic Preservation, P.O. Box 590, Raleigh NC 27602. Desi,

The Prince Hall Historic District was designated in 2012 and the arch was built just a few years prior to designation. While the RHDC cannot require the reversal of changes made to the property prior to district designation, new changes proposed to properties in the historic district are reviewed for their congruity with the RHDC's <u>Design Guidelines</u> document and Prince Hall's Special Character Essay contained in the same document.

Freestanding signage is not characteristic of the Prince Hall neighborhood historically. The area typically had building-mounted signage or were painted directly onto the front façade. Any signage installed on the archway since district designation did not receive COA approval and removal was required.

That said, you are able to submit a major work COA application for the COA Committee to review the potentially precedent-setting work request. We are able to convert the application to a major work on your behalf in the online permit portal, which carries over all existing information you have provided.
