Re: COA Minor Works - description of non-historic & invasive mulberry tree removal

Dear Collette,

Per our recent email exchange, I understand that the removal of the non-contributing mulberry tree described in the attachments to this COA may be removed as a Minor Works approval. As noted in our emails and in the COA attachments, Karin Kaiser's 1985 Master of Landscape Architecture documentation of the Henderson House & Gardens property demonstrate that the mulberry (Morus) to be removed did not exist in Kaiser's detailed planting plan and plant list documentation.

Kaiser's documentation demonstrates the mulberry was introduced (probably seeded) after 1985, well after Henderson passed away in 1969. Having grown for as many as 40 years, the mulberry is increasingly shading the Front Garden, making it increasingly difficult to grow the perennials and shrubs there which are documented in Henderson's photographs.

We therefor request that you approve this Minor Works to remove the 19" diameter non-historic & invasive mulberry tree located as shown on the attached plan.


