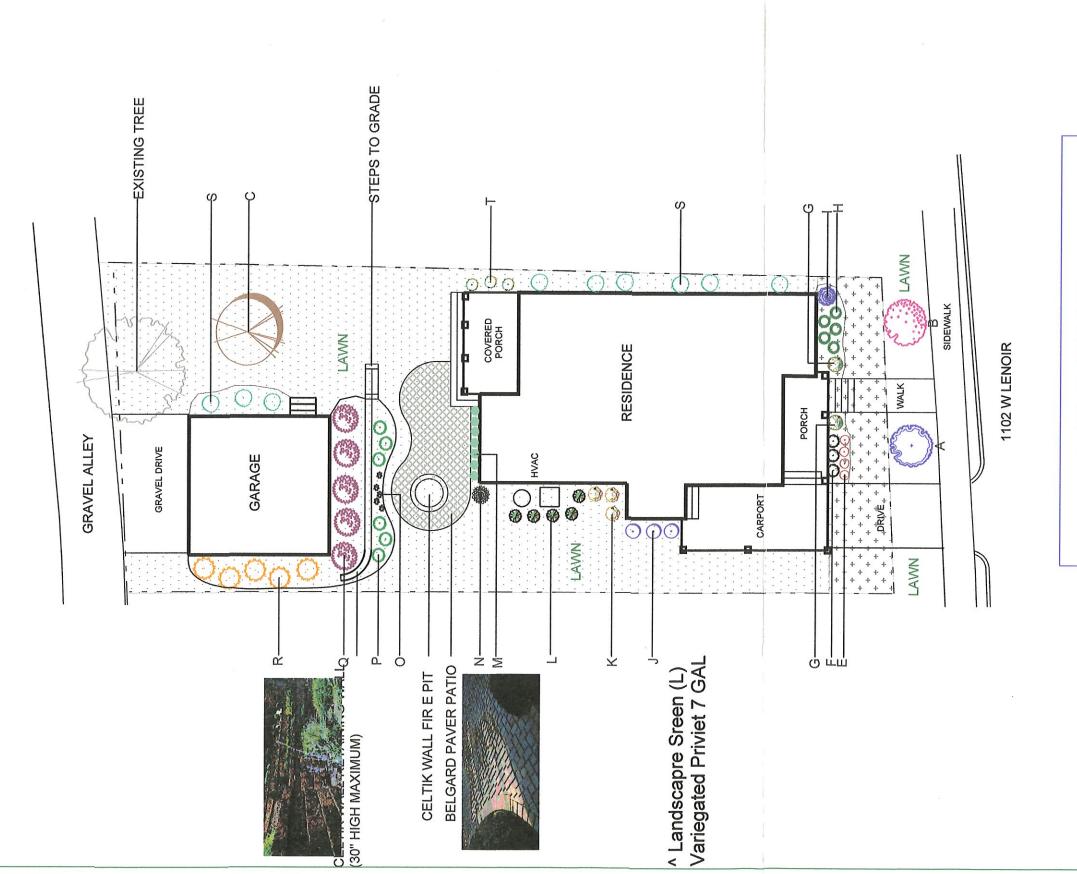

		As shown in the attached drawings, we propose to install A 38' long Celtik-			
		Wall segmental retaining wall in the rear yard. The wall is a maximum of 30 tall when measured from the lower side of the wall. There will be integral			
		landscape steps of the same material. This material has been used			
		previously in contributing structures within the Boylan Heights Historic Overlay district (examples attached). Additionally, a 300sf Belgard paved			
		patio of matching color to the wall is proposed in the rear yard. Centered in			
		the patio will be a Celtik -wall firepit (5' diameter, 24" tall). Plantings are proposed in the front, side, and rear yards. The proposed plantings equal			
		18.6% of the front yard area. The proposed plantings and hardscaping equ			
		23.9% of the side and rear yard area.

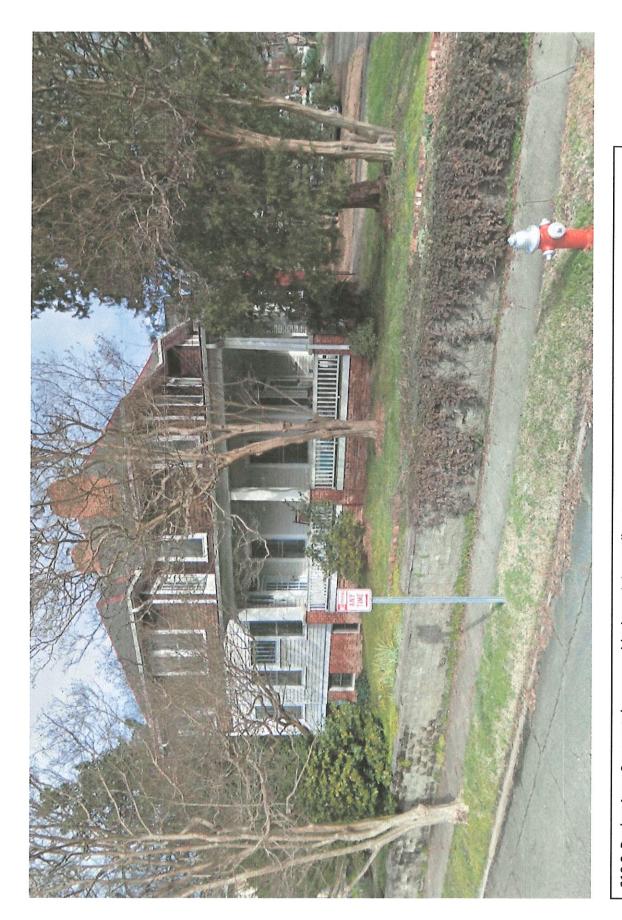
422 Cutler St (Dunbar House): Celtik-wall retaining wall systems with Belgard Pavers (Image 1)



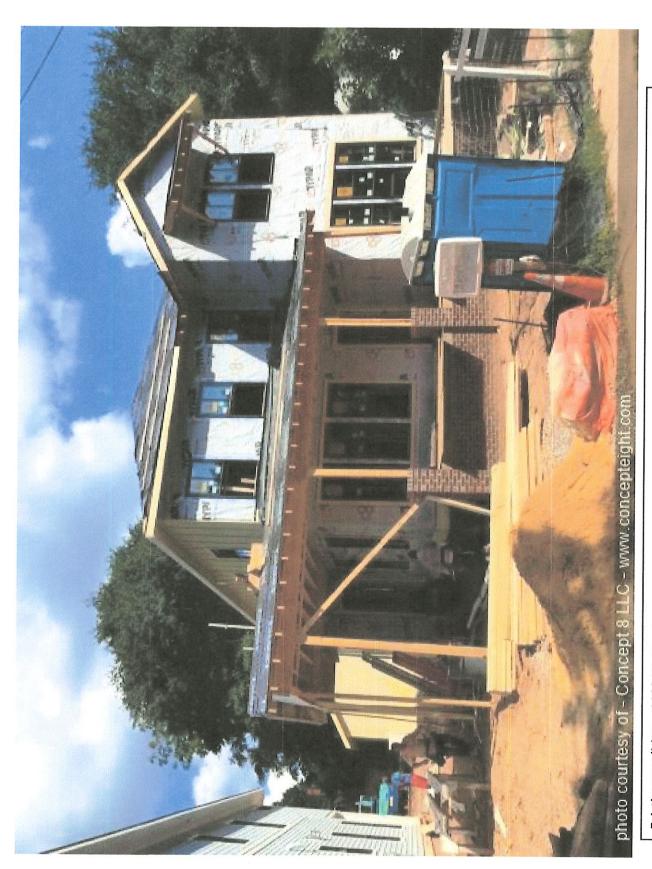
