Scope of work:


Demolish existing decaying deck. Much of the structure has rotted out including several posts.


Repair exterior woodwork and trim damaged by the installation of the existing deck. Install new smaller deck and stairs within the footprint of the existing deck.

#### Referencing the guidelines

- 3.1.1 The work will repair the damage done in constructing the existing deck. The new deck will be independent of the historic structure.
- 3.1.2 The new deck is on the north side of the house, completely hidden from street view.
- 3.1.3 N/A
- 3.1.4 The new deck will align with the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the historic structure. It will be surrounded by plantings.
- 3.1.5 Only the non-historic deck will be removed.
- 3.1.6 The deck is designed to reduce its visual impact on the historic structure relative to the existing deck.
- 3.1.7 At 72' sq the new deck will reduce the proportion of built area to open space relative to the existing 330'sq deck.
- 3.1.8 All work will be within the footprint of the existing deck which is outside of the dripline of all trees.

Thank you for submitting a minor work COA application. The COA application for your project at 519 Polk Street has been approved! In order to limit the number of people entering the City office buildings, we'll be mailing you the signed application and blue placard. It is currently taking a bit longer for mail to be processed through our internal system. You should hopefully receive it by next Friday's mail.

You should submit the blue placard to the Development Services staff for any permits you may need related to this project. We also ask that the placard be posted in a publicly visible location on the property for the duration of the project work.

If you wind up being required to install a side railing, please let us know what you would like to install at that time. Certainly extending the same stair railing design to the side of the deck is approvable. A raised planting bed is likely also approvable with a photograph and material info. You are correct that removing a regulated tree without proposing a replacement tree is considered a major work application.
