Hi Collette,

I am reaching out about Dana Folley's Chinaberry tree located on the property of 710 N Bloodworth Street.

After meeting with Dana on 10/24/18 and performing a visual inspection, I recommend this tree as a candidate for immediate removal. The proximity of this tree to the house is such that the root system is growing against the foundation and the base of the tree is likely applying pressure to the foundation wall. Based on the species, this tree in particular is more susceptible to failure as it is shallow rooted and does not have 100% of its root flares to anchor it in the space.

There is a heavy lean to this tree towards the neighbor's house and property. The failure potential of this species based on the listed observations is high. This tree will be removed with a plan for immediate replacement of a more desirable species. Please reach out with any questions.
