Project Scope Summary:

Brief Overview:

The First Citizens Bank located at 239 Fayetteville St will undergo a complete revitalizing from the inside, out. Exterior façade upgrades on Fayetteville and Martin St. Mechanical systems upgrades building wide. New grand entrance lobby for the bank branch as well for the future tenants. Relocation of the ATM to Martin St. Prep each floor for future tenants.

The one-sentence summary of this project is to take this historic and underutilized building and turn it into a premier office rental space.

Exterior:


The First Citizens Bank project will be an invasive, while selective demolition of the Fayetteville St and Martin St exterior façade. To be replaced with high profile curtain wall systems. The entire exterior of the building will have all the caulk and sealants inspected and repaired to secure a complete and tight building envelope. Existing landscape planters around the building will be removed and replaced with an architectural feature to highlight the modern improvements to the building. The ATM on Fayetteville St will be relocated to Martin St. The current entry to the branch will be adjusted to accommodate the future tenant dedicated entry.


Interior:

The entry lobby will be remodeled to include a grad curtain wall entry lobby with access to the elevators and give entry to the branch. New ceilings to be installed through out the 1st floor. New finishes for the branch areas. Bathroom upgrades on every floor. Tennant shell work to prepare for future construction as tenants are brought on board.

Systems:

A full mechanical, electrical, plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm and elevator system upgrade to bring this building into current code standards.


